Members of Bridges earn "Mommy Money" for attending our classes, as well as many other ways. This mommy money is then used in our boutique to obtain items for members and their children.

We hold our members to a certain code of behavior to instill responsibility and accountability in them.

When does Bridges meet?

After you register for BRIDGES, the first class you will attend will be an orientation class. At the orientation, we will go over our policies, answer any questions you may have, and have you fill out your paperwork.

Beginning the next month you will attend two classes per month.

Bridges will meet on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of each month:

Tuesdays, 3:30 p.m.

These classes last approximately one hour. There are many other ways to earn additional Mommy Money.
